


In order to facilitate the absorption of new immigrants, the State of Israel grants certain benefits. These benefits vary based on the Oleh's status, past, age and family situation. Please note: We can only give a general overview. **This list does not guarantee the benefits, since each case is considered individually by Misrad HaKlita.**

### The Process from Aliyah to Klita



### Possible Benefits:

## 1 Flight Ticket

You might be granted a one-way flight ticket to Israel.



## 2 SIM Card

Upon your arrival at the airport, you will get an Israeli SIM card with free minutes and internet, valid for 3 months.



## 3 Transportation from the Airport

If you arranged it in advance with the Jewish Agency, a free taxi to your first residence will be arranged.



## 4 Financial Assistance (Sal Klita)

If you are eligible for financial assistance, a certain amount of money will be transferred monthly to your bank account during the first 6 months. The amount varies based on several factors such as age and household members. You can calculate here how much you will probably get: [🔗](#)



## 5 Hebrew Ulpan

Adult Olim receive a Hebrew language course for free. All public Ulpans, as well as certain private Ulpans, are fully funded by the government. For more details [click here](#) and/or contact us.



## 6 Basic Health Insurance

During the first 6 months, you will get the basic health insurance, provided by an HMO of your choice, for free. More details about HMOs in Israel you can find here: [📄](#)



## 7 Local Property Tax Discount

If you rent something in the first year of Aliyah, you might get a discount of up to 90% on the local property tax (called Arnona).



## 8 Rental Assistance

You can get a rent subsidy in the first 4 years, while the given amount decreases over time. You will start receiving this rental assistance from the 8th month of your Aliyah.



## 9 Tax Discounts

As a new immigrant you are granted various tax discounts, e.g. on income tax, or on the purchase of a car or a house.



## 10 Customs Benefits

In the first 3 years after your Aliyah you can ship your belonging and household products 3 times and each time this will be tax-free.



## 11 Mortgage Discount

In the first 15 years, you may be eligible for low interest rates when buying your first own property in Israel.



## 12 Tuition Benefit

If you start studying at a university within the first 3 years of your Aliyah, you might get a significant discount on your tuition, depending on your age.



## 13 Aliyah Program for Young Olim

In the first 5 months, young Olim (18-35) might be eligible to participate in an Aliyah program such as Hebrew Ulpan in a Kibbutz or city, preparation for university studies, guidance for employment and preparation for recruitment into the IDF. ## 14 **Merkaz Klita**

Upon request, Olim up to 55 years old might get granted temporary residence (usually for up to 6 months) far below market price in an absorption center (Merkaz Klita).



## 15 **Daycare Reduction**

You might be entitled to a reduction in daycare costs for Maon or Mishpachton in the first 2 years after Aliyah.



## 16 **Foreign Income Tax Break**

If you have an income earned abroad, you might be eligible for tax breaks within the first 10 years of your Aliyah.



### Important Notes:

## ! **Individual Case**

We cannot guarantee any of the mentioned benefits, since the granting of benefits depends on many factors. You can get detailed information on your specific benefits during the interview with your shaliach before Aliyah and with Misrad HaKlita once you are in Israel.



## ! **Special Status**

If you are not an Oleh Chadash, but have a special status, such as Ezech Oleh, Katin Chozer, etc. you might receive less benefits. Check your benefits with your shaliach or with Misrad HaKlita.
